

**NOTICE TO BIDDERS**

**ROWAN ELEVATED TANK  
REPAINTING & REPAIRS**

**BOROUGH OF GLASSBORO  
GLOUCESTER COUNTY, NEW JERSEY**

Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received by the **Borough of Glassboro** for the bid of the following project at **11:00 A.M.** prevailing time on **January 27, 2012**, at the Municipal Building of the Borough of Glassboro, 1 South Main Street, Glassboro, NJ 08028. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at **11:00 A.M.** prevailing time on said date.

The project consists of a full abrasive blast followed by repainting of the interior and exterior of the 500,000 gallon spheroidal elevated tank located on Rowan University campus in Glassboro, NJ. The project will also include miscellaneous repairs and improvements including installation of a new roof vent. All exterior paint removal must be performed by a Certified Lead Abatement Contractor who is licensed in the State of New Jersey. The contractor must perform and complete all work between May 14, 2012 and August 17, 2012. Mobilization to the site prior to May 14, 2012 will not be allowed.

The Bidding Documents may be examined at the office of the Engineer; Sickels & Associates, 833 Kings Highway, Woodbury, New Jersey 08096. Copies of the Bidding Documents may be obtained at this address upon payment of \$175.00. Checks should be made payable to Sickels & Associates, Inc. If contract documents are to be mailed, add twenty dollars (\$20.00) to the cost of the documents. **NO REFUND SHALL BE MADE FOR RETURN OF THESE DOCUMENTS.**

Bids must be submitted on the forms provided within the documents in the manner designated therein. Bids must be enclosed in a sealed envelope bearing the bidder's name and address labeled "**BID FOR ROWAN ELEVATED TANK REPAINTING & REPAIRS**" and addressed to the **Borough of Glassboro, 1 South Main Street, Glassboro, NJ 08028, Attention: Patricia Frontino, Borough Clerk.** If forwarded by mail, the sealed envelopes containing the bid must be enclosed in another envelope addressed to the Borough of Glassboro.

A Pre-Bid Meeting has been scheduled for this project and will be held on **Thursday January 12, 2012** at the **Glassboro Municipal Building** at **10:00 am** and a site visit will follow.

All bidders are required to provide a copy of the contractors and subcontractors business registration certificate(s) issued by the Department of the Treasury in accordance with Section 1 of P.L. 2004, c.57 (C.52:32-44). All Contractors and subcontractors must also comply with the "Public Works Contractor Registration Act" (P.L. 2203, c.91).

Bids must be accompanied by a Certificate of Surety from an acceptable surety and a bid security in the form of a certified check, cashier's check or bid bond payable to the **Borough of Glassboro** in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the total bid amount, but not in excess of \$20,000.00.

The successful bidder must furnish a Performance Bond and Payment Bond, each in the amount equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the contract price. Said bonds must be in a form acceptable to the **Borough of Glassboro** and be issued by a surety authorized to do business in the State of New Jersey. The successful bidder must comply with Affirmative Action requirements pursuant to Public Law 1975 C. 127 (N.J.A.C. 17:27) as revised and amended to date, and must furnish an Initial Project Manning Report (AA201) upon execution of the Agreement.

Contractor is advised of the responsibility to file an annual disclosure statement on political contributions with the New Jersey Election Law Enforcement Commission pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.13 (P.L. 2005, c271, s3) if the contractor receives contracts in excess of \$50,000.00 from public entities in a calendar year. It is the Contractor's responsibility to determine if filing is necessary. The Contracts, if awarded, will be to the lowest responsible bidder whose bid proposal conforms to the requirements set forth in the Contract Documents. The **Borough of Glassboro** will award the Contract or reject the bids within sixty (60) municipal days after the date of the bid opening. Should there be any reason the contract cannot be awarded within the specified period, the time may be extended by mutual agreement between the **Borough of Glassboro** and the bidder.

The **Borough of Glassboro** and the Engineer reserve the right to require a complete financial and experience statement from the prospective bidders showing that they have satisfactorily completed work of the nature required before furnishing proposal forms or specifications, or before awarding the contract.

The **Borough of Glassboro** reserves the right to reject any and all bids in whole or in part, and to waive any informalities or minor defects therein, should it be deemed in the best interest of the **Borough of Glassboro**. The right is also reserved to increase or decrease the quantities specified in the manner designated in the specifications.
