PARADE RULES

- THE PARADE WILL BEGIN PROMPTLY AT 10:00 A.M.!!!
- Line up times are as follows:
 - Division 3 and 4 at 9:15 a.m.
 - Division 1 and 2 at 9:30 a.m.
- In order to avert traffic problems, please do not arrive earlier than the designated time.
- This committee does not provide open cars, vehicles or convertibles for non-marching participants. You must make your own arrangements.
- Any group of children marching must have adults to oversee their safety.
- For the safety of all participants, especially children, driving (and parking) are prohibited on Lehigh Road from Route 322 to Cornell Road from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.
- All vehicles will drop off at the A lot of Rowan University's campus. The lot is located on Route 322. We will provide a shuttle service to the Parade starting point.
- The leader of each group **must** check in with the Marshal who will direct them to their location.
- For the safety of everyone, NO items shall be thrown from moving vehicles. If any participant plans to distribute free items to the crowds along the parade route, please be sure to consult with the parade committee regarding distribution – use caution when distributing items to prevent injury and/or potential hazard spectators and participants.
- All motor vehicle participants (including motorcyclists) will have to provide a copy of a valid inspection, registration, insurance and license in order to participate in the parade. Please include these documents when mailing back the Commitment Form.
- All participants operating a motor vehicle (including motorcycles) and/or travelling the roadway will be expected to follow NJ Title 39 Motor Vehicle Code.
- Any group participating in the parade cannot wear “colors” and/or apparel that represents or is affiliated with gang related activity.
- Motorcycle participants and groups will not be allowed to perform wheelies and/or burnouts and **must** wear a helmet.
- The parade will end at the Veteran's Memorial next to the Fire House. All vehicles and buses picking up parade participants can park behind the old movie theatre located at Academy and High Streets. Out of respect for the theme of the day, you are encouraged to stay for the closing ceremony following the parade.
- The line up is designed to provide a balance between the patriotic theme and the entertainment elements of the parade. It is essential that all participants remain in the order that they are assigned and keep the pace set by the master of ceremony in the front car.
- **All bands are required to play a patriotic song when approaching the Veterans' Memorial located on High Street.**
- **TWO (2) members from each band must carry a Sponsor banner in order for the band to receive payment.**
