PURCHASE LICENSES FOR YOUR NEW DOG AND/OR CAT

RENEW YOUR CURRENT DOG AND/OR CAT LICENSES

IT'S TIME TO LICENSE YOUR PET(S). Current dog and cat licenses expire January 31, 2012. We extend a grace period through **March 30, 2012**. Any license issued April 1st or after is subject to a \$10.00 late fee. Licenses may be purchased Monday through Friday, between 8:30 A.M. and 4:00 P.M., in the office of the Borough Clerk. Please bring an updated rabies certificate for each dog/cat, along with proof that your pet has been spayed/neutered. **ALL PETS MUST BE LICENSED – INCLUDING INDOOR DOGS/CATS. STATE LAW REQUIRES THAT RABIES VACCINATION MUST BE CURRENT TO NOVEMBER 1ST OF THE LICENSING YEAR. FEES CAN NOW BE PAID BY CASH, DEBIT OR CREDIT CARD.**

Spayed/Neutered dog or cat:	\$12.00
Non-spayed/Non-Neutered dog/cat:	\$15.00

To obtain licenses through the mail, please forward all necessary information along with a check made payable to the Borough of Glassboro (**separate checks for dogs and cats**), and a self-addressed stamped envelope with sufficient postage, to the Borough of Glassboro, Pet Licensing, 1 South Main Street, Glassboro, NJ 08028-2592.

We are happy to report that we will again be offering our **FREE RABIES CLINIC**. The clinic will be held on Saturday, January 28, 2012, at the Highway Garage, 125 Grove Street, from **1:00 P.M. to 3:30 P.M.** No appointment is necessary; however, serum will only be available while supplies last. All pets must be on a leash (**NO FLEXI-LEADS**) or in a carrier. **ALL DOGS OVER 30 POUNDS MUST BE MUZZELED OR THEY WILL BE DENIED ACCESS.** For your convenience, licenses will be issued on the same Saturday, January 28, 2012, from 12:30 to 3:30 P.M. in the office of the Borough Clerk, 1 South Main Street, Glassboro. **PLEASE KEEP IN MIND - NO PETS ARE PERMITTED IN BOROUGH HALL.**
