‘WHERE THE WILD THINGS ARE’ FEATURED AT GLASSBORO FREE MOVIES IN THE PARK EVENT

GLASSBORO – Families are invited to a free screening of *Where the Wild Things Are* on Friday, June 18 at dusk (around 8:00 p.m.) in Glassboro’s New Street Park. The viewing is part of the annual Movies in the Park initiative, sponsored by the Gloucester County Board of Chosen Freeholders and hosted in Glassboro by the Main Street Organization.

The film will be shown on a 16' x 9' inflatable screen with a sound system provided by the Gloucester County Freeholder’s annual Movies in the Park program. Interested families are encouraged to bring blankets, lawn chairs, and pillows to enjoy the movie. All children must be accompanied by an adult.

With a family rating of “PG,” these free movie showings are intended to promote quality family recreational activities in the region. Glassboro has participated in the program for six years, showing family movies in various outdoor locations throughout the Borough.

Where the Wild Things Are brings Maurice Sendak’s beloved children's book to the big screen. A mixture of real actors, computer animation and live puppeteering, the movie follows the adventures of a boy named Max as he enters the world of the Wild Things, a race of strange and enormous creatures who gradually make him their king.

“It is great when we can partner with another civic entity to provide a family fun activity to our residents. I applaud the County Freeholders for their commitment to continually trying to improve the quality of life throughout Gloucester County,” said Councilman Ed Malandro.

The Glassboro Unity Day Committee and Main Street Glassboro coordinate community events throughout the year.
