SOUTHBOUND MAIN STREET IN DOWNTOWN GLASSBORO TO BE DETOURED OCT. 24-27 FOR REPAVING PROJECT

GLASSBORO--The Borough of Glassboro has announced that downtown detours will be in place on southbound Main Street (Alt. Rte. 553) from Victoria Street to High Street from Monday, October 24 through Thursday, October 27. The detour will be in effect from 7:00 a.m.-4:00 p.m. on each day to accommodate repaving of the roadway, as part of a road widening project. The road will be reopened to two-way traffic at the end of each day. There will be no detours in place for northbound traffic.

Vehicles traveling southbound on Main Street will be detoured onto Victoria Street, to Rowan Boulevard, to Poplar then on to High Street and finally back to Main Street.

Also as part of the road widening project, the New Jersey Transit bus stop located on the southbound side of Main Street (between the former Lew's Auto and the former Down on Main Street Bar) will be permanently relocated northward approximately 400 ft. in front of the Barnes & Noble Bookstore parking lot. This change will go into effect November 1. The Borough of Glassboro is working with New Jersey Transit to inform the riding public as well as bus drivers of the change.

The New Jersey Transit bus stop located on the northbound side of Main Street (at Angelo's Diner) will remain in its current location for the present time.
